When you join us in Geneva, you can expect health and safety to be a priority. A range of measures are in place to ensure everyone involved is able to enjoy a safe, hygienic, productive and high-quality organised experience.

ARRIVAL TO SWITZERLAND:

All international participants from the EU/EEA/Schengen area will have to have a valid EU Covid Digital Certificate to enter the country. For more information on this, and if you are travelling from a country outside this area, please check the following links for what is required:

EVENT ENTRY

All participants will be asked not to attend if they are feeling unwell or showing any symptoms of COVID-19, and teams will follow local health authority guidance on detecting and managing anyone displaying symptoms. All delegates will be asked to show proof of a Covid Digital Certificate on entry to the event.

Because of this, in accordance with the current Swiss guidelines, we will not make mask wearing compulsory at the event. We do understand and respect, however, if some people still choose to wear one.

ENHANCED CLEANING

The Feedinfo Summit will work with the venue to ensure the highest standards of hygiene and cleanliness. This includes continuous sanitation throughout the course of the event, with a focus on high-touch areas such as door handles, restrooms and food and beverage areas.



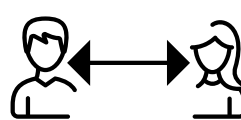
PERSONAL HYGIENE
